New & improved invoicing

From the latest invoice you have received, all contracts are “normalized” to have a start date the 1st of each month. For some contracts this is however not possible – for example domains that have a specific start date. These stand with the original contract date. This means that we now, the 30th of November, will invoice all contracts that begin in January 2014. Contract periods running from January 1st – February 1st are invoiced normally. If the contract period runs from January 15th – February 15th, the invoice will only apply to the dates January 15th – February 1st. The following month, the invoice will state February 1st – February 29th.

New services that have been ordered, for example on the 15th of November, will be invoiced with a correction period from November 15th – December 1st, and also for the entirety of December 2013 and January 2014. After this correction, the contract is “up to date” and the next invoice will be for the entire month of February. You can also get invoices through email. More about it: www.rackfish.com/invoicing
